Introduction to Biblical Spiritual gifts

Gift Descriptions and Characteristics

Spiritual Gifts- Any ability that a Christian beleiver is given by the Holy Spirit and is used to edify the body of Christ.

During Pentecost the Holy Spirit filled the body of Christ and gave supernatural gifts to the Church so that they can do the work of Christ (Acts 2:4) and build the Church. We are still called to build Christ's Church until his second coming (Mathew 28:18). Paul writes about the spiritual gifts the most in the New Testament, and has given four lists of gifts. These are not an exhaustive list but they are the only ones talked about in the Bible.

All persons that believe that Christ Jesus is their Savior has been given a Spiritual Gift to be used for building Christ's church. We are all called to use our gift to serve others and administer Christ's grace to others (1 Peter 4:10). As the body of Christ it is each of our responsibility to be good stewards with our time and our gifts so that the whole body functions properly and efficiently (1 Corinthians 12:12-31).

Here are some notes that may help you utilize your gift better within the body.

• We need to exercise our gift and not neglect it.(1 Tim 4:14, 2 Tim 1:6)

Use your gift regularly so that through experience and practice you learn how to use it in accordance with Christ's plan. This applies to some more than others such as teaching or evangelism.

All gifts need to be used with wisdom and maturity to edify the body (1 Corinthians 14)

Paul talks in 1 Corinthians 14 about order within the church body as well as in the service. He reminds us to be orderly, mature, and practical in the way we exercise our gifts. He also reminds us that these gifts are for the edification of the church body (1 Cor 14: 4, 5)

Weigh everything against what scripture says (1 Cor 14:29)

Remember that the Bible is basic instruction. If something does not agree with what the Bible says it is not from Christ.

• Remember that some people have multiple gifts.

Many of the gifts mesh together in their workings. For example Administration and Leadership are very similar in their workings and responsibilities. Often times a person with one of these gifts will exercise the other at the same time. We need to find where we best utilize our total gift, passions, and abilities package within the Church.

Aspire to the greater gifts (1 Cor 12:31)

Many say that the meaning of this passage is that there are greater gifts than others such as Prophecy (1 Cor 14:5) and that we should aspire to have those gifts. This belief contradicts what he says in CH 13:2 where he states that if he has Prophecy but not Love he is nothing. Remember that if we do not exercise our gifts out of Love for Christ then it is nothing.

Paul goes on to talk after this passage and talks about Love being the greatest gift. Please read 1 Corinthians 13.

On the following pages are brief descriptions and characteristics of each Spiritual Gift. Please read through all and pay special attention to the ones you ranked highest on during the survey. If you feel that the descriptions and your survey results contradict each other pray about it and then seek the counsel of someone that knows you well and is familiar with Spiritual gifts. Remember this packet is not perfect or absolute truth so do not be discouraged if the survey does not pinpoint you exactly.

Administration: The divine enabling to effectively organize people and resources within the Church to efficiently accomplish ministry goals.

People with this gift

- Are effective at organizing people and resources
- Can analyze information and come to a decision of direction.
- Know how and to whom to delegate tasks to accomplish more within the ministry.
- Have great foresight to know what needs to be done.

Apostleship: The Divine enabling to start new ministry endeavors within and outside the walls of your local church community so that people come to Christ through these new ministries.

People with this gift

- Have a driving desire to see people come to Christ.
- Dream and execute new methods to spread the love of Christ
- Are willing to take risks to see these ventures through
- Are willing to work very hard to see new ministries be successful

Compassion: The Divine enabling ability to serve others by showing love, sympathy, concern, mercy, and kindness to people who are suffering physically, mentally, emotionally, spiritually, or relationally. This gift is also called the gift of Mercy

People with this gift

- Show great concern for people that are hurting or suffering.
- Want to practically help people with service, prayer, or counseling.
- Find ways to help others that they instinctively know need help.

Discernment: The Divine enabling to encounter a teaching, problem, or course of action and know whether or not it is from God or Satan.

People with this gift

- Know when someone's motives are not from God.
- Know when a teaching is not correct according to the scripture.

Encouragement: The Divine enabling come along side a struggling brother or sister and counsel them to live a Christ centered life through inspiring words, encouragement, and counseling to depend on Christ for strength.

People with this gift

- Seek to find people struggling in their walk and encourage them to stronger faith.
- Want to see people fully depend and follow Christ.
- Are happy to see others succeed.

Evangelism: The Divine enabling to share and show Christ's love to others that are not Christians in a way that eventually brings them to faith in Jesus.

People with this gift

- Have the wisdom to know when and with whom to share their salvation story.
- Are sensitive to the Holy Spirit's work in someone's life.
- Deeply desire to see people know Christ personally.
- Can easily share their testimony
- Seek to build relationships with non believers, for the purpose of eventually sharing Christ with them.

Faith: The Divine enabling to know and trust that Christ will accomplish his purpose during times of struggle and unknown variables in the future.

People with this gift

- Know that Christ is unshakeable.
- Know that Christ's will not fail.
- Are challenged by the seemingly impossible.
- Will stand firm when all seems to have failed.

Giving: The Divine enabling to be sensitive and to detect material or financial needs of people within the church or areas of need within the ministry of the church.

People with his gift

- Desire to give above and beyond the tithe for the advancement of the Church.
- Prefer to be anonymous givers.
- Seek out new ways to build their wealth for the purpose of giving more.
- Understand that their money is not theirs but God's and give accordingly.
- Are good stewards of the financial blessings that God has given them.

Healing: The Divine enabling to be used to miraculously heal the sick, hurting, or suffering.

People with this gift

- Know they have this gift.
- Trust in the ability that Christ can heal people supernaturally.
- Pray that God would use them to heal others.
- Give God all the glory when there is a healing.

Helps: The Divine enabling to find ways to serve the Church ministry or members of the Family in ways that are beneficial to the lives of those helped.

People with this gift

- Seek out ways to help people that need help.
- Often do their ministry unbeknownst to others.
- Are humble and do not seek glory for themselves.
- Try to be as available to help others as often as possible.

Interpretation of Tongues: The Divine enabling to interpret a language that is unknown by the speaker or those in attendance. This language can be the utterances of Heaven (1 Cor 14:2) or an Earthly language (Acts 2:6).

People with this gift

- Know they have this gift.
- Are able to translate a language that is unknown to them or the receiving party into a
 message that edifies, exhorts, or comforts those in attendance (believers or unbelievers
 (1 Cor 14:2)
- Are to be present when another believer is speaking in Tongues.

Knowledge: The Divine enabling to know the truth about a person or situation revealed by the Holy Spirit to promote honesty, justice, and understanding among the Body.

People with this gift

- Know and understand Scripture due to their consistent reading and studying.
- Sometimes receive visions or unexplained insight about a person or situation.
- Need to weigh their insight against Scripture

Leadership: The Divine enabling to go first into a situation or plan and have others follow.

People with this gift

- Have the trust of those following
- Are visionaries for the Church, they see problems or obstacles and plan how to overcome as a group.

- Know how to motivate others to follow
- · Are able to delegate to others
- Have people following them!

Miracles: The Divine enabling to perform supernatural acts that brings validity to Christ.

People with this gift

- Know that they have this gift.
- Know that only through Jesus Christ should anything supernatural be done.
- Are devoted to prayer, and have faith that Christ can move mountains.
- Are humble about their gifting.

Pastorship: The Divine enabling to serve, lead, train, and take responsibility for a group of believers in their walk with Christ.

People with this gift

- Want to see people live out their full potential for Christ.
- Seek ways to serve people within the Body.
- Know when danger or attack is coming near the Body that they are responsible, and prepare and defend accordingly with the power of Christ.
- Build strong relationships with the group that they are responsible for.
- Understand that they are held to a higher standard and will be judged accordingly by Christ. Pastors should act according to this understanding.

Prophecy: The Divine enabling to edify the Church by revealing messages from God that calls for repentance, gives comfort, forecasts trouble, or reveals sin within the body.

People with this gift

- Know the teachings of the Bible are superior and prophecy accordingly.
- Share convictions with people within the body
- Are revealed messages from Christ to share within the Church
- Display Godly courage in confronting sin within the body.

Teaching: The Divine enabling to teach Biblical doctrine to the Body, utilizing effective teaching methods so that others may understand the truths of the Bible.

People with this gift

- Devote countless hours to studying Scripture, so as to better understand and teach.
- Are able to communicate clearly and effectively to groups of people.
- Seek out new methods and opportunities to teach the Bible to others.

- Desire that members of the Body clearly understand the Word.
- Understand the need of practicing to become a better teacher.

Tongues: The Divine enabling to speak an unknown Earthly Language to communicate a message from Christ (Acts 2). Also used to pray in the Heavenly language mentioned in 1 Corinthians 14.

People with this gift

- Know that they have this gift.
- Have spoken a language that was previously unknown, for the purpose of sharing a message from Christ.
- Have spoken in utterances during their personal prayer life.
- While in the presence of the body know to use this gift with maturity and with the accompaniment of an interpreter.

Wisdom: The Divine enabling to make wise decisions in a time of conflict or time of indecisiveness within the Body, or to counsel someone to make wise decisions in accordance with the Bible.

People with this gift

- Understand and know how to act in accordance with Scripture.
- They have consistently displayed wise decision making in their personal life.
- Have had a vast array of experiences in life.
- Enjoy counseling others through tough times.
- Know that the source of all wisdom is form Christ.

Other gifts mentioned in Scripture:

Marriage/Celibacy (1 Cor 7:7): Although this is mentioned as a Gift it is clear that is meant as situational gift, meaning that no matter the situation in your life, single or married you need to serve Christ to the fullest extent possible in the current situation you are blessed with.

Hospitality (1 Peter 4:9-10): Every believer should utilize the blessings given by Christ to assist in the building of the Church, including opening your house up to others for meals or boarding.

Intercession (1 Timothy 2:1-2)- this is not mentioned as a gift but as a responsibility for all believers.

Craftsmanship (Exodus 31:3)- This gift is not mentioned in the New Testament but will be addressed under Natural abilities.

Music/Singing/ or Creative Arts (Psalm 150:3-5): These are natural abilities that can be inspired by the Holy Spirit.

Note: Although this list is not an exhaustive list of possibilities of gifts that the Holy Spirit has given it is a list of what the New Testament mentions. This list is not final either, the Holy Spirit can move whenever and on whomever he pleases as he sees fit to build his Church. This means that just because you do not currently example a specific gift does not mean

that the Holy Spirit cannot give it to you when needed.

The Passions of my heart

What are the passions of your heart?

Passion: An intense or overpowering emotion such as love, joy, hatred, or anger.

Fervor, Obsession, Infatuated, enthusiasm, Zeal, Delight

What things drive you to have emotions such as Love, Joy, Hatred or Anger and how can you apply these to your ministry within the Church Body. As Christians we need to be passionate about one thing: bringing Glory to Christ. We do this by worshipping him and sharing Christ's Gospel to people that have not experienced his unlimited Grace and Love. For our church to fully accomplish its goals we need you to serve in areas of need that you can be passionate about. In the following questions we will ask you what areas of ministry that you think you could serve passionately in.
